

Help With Transportation or Housing

AIDS patients from Niagara County who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless can find transitional housing at Community Missions of the Niagara Frontier, 1570 Buffalo Ave., Niagara Falls.

Two rooms there have been designated as “Mark’s Place” residences specifically for people who have been diagnosed with AIDS and who want to live in Niagara County even though their medical providers are in Buffalo.

Residents must be at least 18 years old and ambulatory, continent and able to provide self-care. There is a fee based on entitlements and ability to pay. Call 285-3403 for more information and an application.
